



THREE-STEP PROCESS

1. The REI releases a Competitive RFP to solicit bid proposals from Qualified Residential Solar Providers (QRSPs) to install Residential Solar PV Systems on residential homes located within the Municipality at a discounted price.
2. The REI will analyze proposals for the Municipality.
3. The Municipality selects the QRSP under the Residential Solar Aggregation Program.

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WHAT IS THE PROGRAM?

The purpose of the Residential Solar Aggregation Program is to solicit and attract highly qualified residential solar photovoltaic (PV) providers to participate in a competitive RFP to provide municipal residents significant discounts on the cost of their residential solar PV systems.

The Renewable Energy Institute (REI), a non-profit subsidiary of the Renewable Energy and Efficiency Business Association, Inc. (REEBA), administers the Residential Solar Aggregation Program at NO COST to the Municipality.
